Minutes

Bev read the minutes of May 20, 2009. A motion was made by Leland to approve the minutes. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Bills

Leland read the bills. A motion was made by Leland to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Review Noise Ordinances

John Stark, a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission, brought in the proposed Noise Ordinance. The council went over the different points in the proposed ordinance. Mayor Atwood said that he will look into whose responsibility it was to hold the Public Hearing.

The Council commended John for his diligent work regarding this ordinance. Mayor Atwood said that the Council would go over the proposed ordinance and forward any recommendations to the Commission.

Building Permit – Grant Norman – 8635 S 300 W – Enclose Patio

The Council went over the permit and saw that all was in order. A motion was made by Leland to approve the permit. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – There was an extensive discussion on the condition of the road by the cemetery. Leland suggested that it be graded before it is sprayed for dust. Lee will check with Margaret. Lee turned into the county the 10 blocks that need to be chipped & sealed.
- **Water** – Bev reported on the delinquent water customers.
- **Community** - Mat reported on the Paradise Farmers Market. They are scheduled to begin on July 8th. Mat went over the sidewalks by the park, marking the raised areas with orange paint. Lee reported that Audra Jackson will be driving the float in the Hyrum Parade on the 4th.

New Business

- Leland reported that the Town Tractor is not drivable at this point. Lee will get an estimate for the repair and report back to the Council.
- Leland suggested that we think about hiring an employee that could be over Public Works/Development Assistant. Leland will do some checking on what suitable wages would be.
- Mat will ask all 4 Bishops to announce the election vacancies in Sacrament Meeting.
