Bills

Margaret read the bills of May 2, 2012. A motion was made by Margaret to accept the bills as read. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Minutes

Building Permits

Mayor Howlett reviewed the Haslem building permit. All looked in order. A motion was made by Margaret to approve the permit. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.
- Tyler & Casey Rowley – 9195 S 300 W – New Home

Amend 2011 – 2012 Budget/Discuss 2012-2013 Budget

Mayor Howlett led an extensive discussion on the amended 2011-2012 budget. We will schedule the Public Hearing for June 6, 2012. There was an extensive discussion on whether Paradise Town should fund an engineering study to reassess the floodplain. If we were to fund the study we would have to have a Public Hearing to adjust a mill levy to pay for the study. Mayor Howlett reported that we will probably hear more on this topic in the months to come.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Jay passed out a bid from Larsen Asphalt to slurry seal 9200 S between 100 East & 200 East and 9000 S between the church and the canal. The bid was for \$14,280.00. The other bid that we have was from Morgan Pavement for \$13,919.00. We will put this item on May 16th agenda.
- **Water** – Mayor Howlett and Lee Atwood will attend the County Planning and Zoning meeting for the conditional use permit for the water tank on May 3rd.

- **Community-** Kyle Smith was asked if there was any money to allocate to the Town's sports programs. There are some children in the Town that are unable to pay the fees necessary to play. Perhaps some of the Trout & Berry money can be allocated to this fund. Bev reported that Suzanne Marychild mentioned that the Farmers Market is going to run the same as it did last year, so she didn't think she needed to come and meet with the Town. Margaret reported that the Youth Council was a big help at the Easter Egg Hunt.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Dale reported that the First Responders had saved a woman's life this past week.

Mayor Howlett reported that he will include in the newsletter the date of the Public Hearing and the Town clean-up ordinance.
