Minutes

No minutes were read at this meeting.

Bills

Margaret read the bills of October 17, 2012. A motion was made by Jay and seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Cache County Sheriff – Law Enforcement & Animal Control Contract

The contract amount for the law enforcement contract is \$3,366.00 for 73 service hours per month. This amount is unchanged from last year. A motion was made by Margaret to accept this contract. Seconded by Dale. The animal control contract is billing us \$28.00 an hour or \$2000.00 a year. This is for 6 hours a month. A motion was made by Margaret to accept this contract for the same amount as last year. Seconded by Dale. All in favor.

Fire Department

Blake reported that the department had just completed their youth training classes. Blake also told the Council that they have had 6 or 7 volunteers as a result of the sign they had posted as you come into town. Troy asked if the gravel pit would be available for the Thanksgiving trap shoot. Mayor Howlett told him that the leaks had been patched. The back filling and fence still needs to be done. The work should all be done by the trap shoot.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Nothing to report at this time.
- **Water** – Mayor Howlett reported on the status of the water tank. All looks good with the patching of the leaks.
- **Community-** Margaret suggested that the town set a goal of winning the city beautiful contest that the League sponsors. She suggested that we take before pictures. Mayor Howlett suggested that the town issue another letter to Mr. Casperson. Dale suggested that the Derricott's also be sent another letter. Margaret suggested that something be put in the upcoming newsletter.

- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Nothing to report at this time.

- Mayor Howlett discussed the conditional use permit that the Roland Leishman holds. It states in the permit that when Kristine Leishman is no longer in the home that the conditional use permit is null and void. They have 90 days to vacate the second residence.
