The fourth finding had to do with our general unreserved fund balance. We were approximately \$6,000.00 over the 75% maximum requirement.

Council Reports

They are also running the stop sign on 9100 South. Mayor Howlett reported that the stop signs on 8800 South are also being run. - **Water** – The water tank project is complete and the fence is getting ready to be installed.
- **Community**- Margaret reported that she had the Christmas lights. She wanted to discuss what was being done with the citizens that were in violation of the junk ordinance. Mayor Howlett suggested that we send notices through another avenue other than certified letters.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – Dale reported that Chief Fredrickson spoke about recruitment issues in his ward's sacrament meeting.
