Minutes

Bills

Budget

Leland presented a preliminary budget to the council, and changes were made to the budget amount for the new park. Current year budget amendments were also discussed. A motion was made by Margaret to set the public hearing date for May 15th to discuss the current year budget amendment and the budget for next year as stated by the Mayor. Seconded by Dale. All in favor. A motion was made by Margaret to accept the Mayor's budget draft with the stated changes for the 2013 fiscal year. Seconded by Jay. All in favor.

Council Reports

- **Roads** – Jay has received one bid for paving the roads. Further discussion about which roads to pave, crack seal, and paving the cemetery.
- **Water** – Nothing to report at this time.
- **Community-** Roll off dumpster will be in Town for at least another week and a half.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget** – The Fire Department is planning to do an extrication exercise at the gravel pit. Troy contacted the state for the unseen check, and it should be in the mail this next week.

Unfinished Business

At the settlement conference for the Water Condemnation lawsuit on the 22nd of April, Ray Balls agreed to settle. No response has been received by the other parties. The Town's attorney is drafting the settlement paperwork for Mr. Balls and it is anticipated

that formal approval for that partial settlement will be brought to the Town Council at the May 15th meeting.

New Business

LeGrande Johnson is taking off fourteen inches of top soil at the new park in certain areas and are going to grate the soccer fields in trade.
