NEW PARK – The Park Committee headed up by Jason Summers has put together an application for RAPZ Tax funding for this upcoming year. We have some remaining funds from last year’s award that we will use to install some of the irrigation water system. The next project will be to get a dust control system put in for the arena and plant the grass for the soccer fields. We also are working a topsoil/pit run/grading trade so we can get parking areas in place this summer.

DOG TAGS - We had a good Doc Clinic on Saturday March 2nd and appreciate having Clay Robinson DVM there to give shots as needed for community K-9s. It seemed that even though we were pretty busy down there, we only tagged about half of the dogs that were registered last year. The cost for tags before April 1st is \$5 for “fixed” and \$15 for “unfixed” dogs. After April 1st fees double to \$10 and \$30 so it is best to get in to the Town Office soon with your proof of current rabies.

There are also some dogs around the neighborhoods that don’t ever seem to be registered and we will be relying on the Animal Control folks from the County Sherriff Office to help us get them properly tagged and immunized - but we prefer to use our contract hours with them for patrols and problem solving rather than licensing.

OFFICE HOURS - Unfortunately, Bev will be out of the office for a while beginning March 20th for a medical procedure and recovery. During that time, the office will be closed except when we will have a substitute there during the following hours:

We will also be checking the answering machine daily.
