

**Paradise Town Council Meeting
September 3, 2014
7:30 p.m.**

Council Members Present: Mayor Leland Howlett, Margaret Obray, Spencer Winn, Alyssa Petersen (recorder)

Excused: Jay Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith

Townspeople Present: Ted and Judy Woolf, Blake Pulsipher

Minutes: Due to the absence of Jay Rinderknecht and Kyle Smith there was not a full quorum to approve the minutes of August 11 and August 20.

Bills: Margaret read the bills. Margaret made a motion to approve the bills, Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Building Permits:

Ted Woolf Lot line Adjustment 85 W. 8800 S. - The Council went over the paperwork turned in by the Woolfs. The Woolfs had turned in all their paperwork a month earlier but decided they wanted to wait and think about the Lot Line Adjustment before officially having it signed by the Mayor. The Woolfs then decided they wanted to move ahead with this. There was discussion on the 500.00 fee and if part of it was refundable or not. The Council read the Ordinance that specified it was a “fee” and said nothing about any part of it being refundable. The Council did remind them that before any building permit can be issued they will need to move/take down a barn that straddles the proposed boundary line. The Woolfs understand this requirement and will make the necessary adjustments before any building permits can be issued. Margaret made a motion to approve the Lot Line Adjustment, Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Council Reports:

- **Roads-** Jay was excused from this meeting.
- **Water-** Kyle was excused from this meeting.
- **Community** – Margaret wondered about the possibility of getting some fertilizer on the grass at the new park. The Council will make the necessary arrangements to get this done before winter.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget-** Blake Pulsipher brought in \$1098.00 for the Trout and Berry Days Breakfast and reported that attendance was down this year. The \$1098.00 was the total brought in and not the profit made off of the breakfast. They served approximately 350 people. Blake also reported that the Fire Department will be doing an extrication drill on the 24th of September at the Paradise gravel pits. They will be using an old car that will be delivered to the gravel pits that morning or the night before.

Unfinished Business: No unfinished business at this time.

New Business: No new business at this time.

Margaret made a motion to adjourn; Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor. Meeting adjourns at 8:15 p.m.
