

Paradise Town Council Meeting
January 7, 2015
7:00 p.m.

Council Members Present: Mayor Leland Howlett, Margaret Obray, Jay Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith, Spencer Winn, Alyssa Petersen (recorder)

Minutes: The minutes of December 17, 2014 were emailed to all the Council members previous to the meeting. Margaret made a motion to approve the minutes, Kyle seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills: Spencer read the bills; Jay made a motion to approve the bills as corrected, Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

Council Reports:

- **Roads-** Jay talked to the County about helping with the snowy roads, they have been very busy and weren't able to work a quote out yet. The weather has been very mild so it hasn't been a big issue yet. Mayor Howlett thinks that the County will be reasonable and work with us for the rest of the winter. They came and helped plow the canyon road when Mayor Howlett called them. Jay would like to see a little sand on some of the slick corners in Town. There is a meeting with UDOT on Monday Feb 9, 2014 to talk about the state-wide Transportation Improvement Program, it will be held in Ogden. Mayor Howlett asked if anyone would like to attend that. Mayor Howlett will try to attend. The Council members will check their schedules and see if they can attend. Mayor Howlett was able to get new tires on the Town truck.
- **Water-** The contractor from Salt Lake will be putting the new pump, wire, and discharge column in January 8, 2015. There was a video inspection of the well and casings done last week and everything looked good. Mayor Howlett is hoping to get most of the big work done before the weather gets too bad.
- **Community-** Margaret would like to form a Youth Council again this coming spring or summer.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget-** The Fire Department had 14 calls over the last 3 weeks. They had 2 accidental shootings, 6 medicals, a flood at the church house, and 1 house fire. The Fire Department had enough people to cover the calls. Troy did pass on that he would like to buy coats for everyone in the Fire Department. The Fire Department has been given \$500.00 per year for the purchase of T-shirts, hats, coats, etc., for the past 3 years it has not been used and has accumulated. Troy would like to use that \$1500.00 to purchase the coats.

Unfinished Business: Chris, the Town's Engineer, has put together a plat and surveyed the Park property. The final subdivision process will go to Planning and Zoning at the meeting to be held January 22, 2014.

New Business: The Park Committee and the Lion's Club met last night and hope to have plans to bring before the Council at the next meeting. They went over plans for the pavilion and restrooms. The Committee feels they need to work with an architect or engineer on the pavilion design. They are hoping to work with Nucor and get some steel donated. They discussed pricing, electrical, building, plumbing, and color options. Kyle reported that there were 5 to 6 people that attended the meeting.

Adjourn: Kyle made a motion to adjourn; Jay seconded that motion, all in favor. Meeting adjourns at 7:36 p.m.
