**DOG LICENSES FOR 2015** – The annual Dog Registration Clinic will be held in late February or early March where dogs can be licensed and any required shots can be taken care of. If you don't wish to come license your dog(s) at that time, you can get with Alyssa at the office. Make sure that you have your proof of rabies shots with you when you come to the office or clinic.

Remember that the current limit for dogs in Paradise Town is 3 per home. For those that have a properly licensed kennel, additional dogs may be kept provided that the provisions of the kennel requirements are continuously adhered to.

**COLD WEATHER AND SNOW REMOVAL** – It seems that we have very few days of cold or stormy weather, but we really should have another few weeks of winter. If you have had problems in the past with having your water service freezing, please keep a trickle running if we get several days of zero degree weather – especially if we don't have any snow on the ground to help insulate the ground from the cold.

Speaking of snow, please keep your vehicles parked well off the roadway when it is stormy since it makes it much more dangerous and difficult for snow removal. Also it is very helpful to have dumpsters put on the road on Wednesday morning and promptly removed that afternoon if it is snowing.
