

**Paradise Town Council Meeting**  
**Aug 26, 2015**  
**7:30 p.m.**

**Council Members Present:** Mayor Karen Rinderknecht, Margaret Obray, Jay Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith, Spencer Winn, Alyssa Petersen (recorder)

**Townpeople Present:** Richard and Brenda Medsker, Kaden Musselman

**Minutes:** Jay made a motion to accept the minutes as emailed, Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Bills:** Jay read the bill list; Kyle made a motion to approve the bills as read, Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Public Comment:** Kaden Musselman attended the meeting to show the Council the work he has completed for his Eagle Scout Project. He poured a cement pad around the shed at the new park. He brought in pictures of the pad and told the Council he will backfill the dirt around the pad. Jay suggested Kaden smooth out any ruts that were left by the cement truck. Kaden understands this and will fill the ruts in when he backfills around the cement pad. The water line is broke and Jay suggested that Kaden wait until the water is working. Jay will have a skid steer by next week and can bring in a couple loads of dirt.

Shane Zilles attended the meeting to introduce himself. He is the deputy assigned to Paradise. He reported that they will have a booth and bring the Swat truck to Trout and Berry Days. They will have a deputy in the front and back of the Parade for traffic control and a deputy to help with traffic for the 5K fun run.

**Annexation Petition- Richard Medsker:** The Council looked over the petition and the maps turned in by the Medskers and asked them some questions about the exact location of the land they wish to annex. Margaret asked why they wanted to annex the 1.38 acres; the Medskers believe that it would be easier to sell if it were part of the Town. The Medskers believe there are currently two building lots within the town limits and that a potential third lot could be created with the piece to be annexed. If 300 west is ever continued to the south it could run directly through the annexed piece. The Medskers do not plan on subdividing the piece right now. Margaret made a motion to accept the annexation petition; Jay seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Discuss Planning Commission Vacancies:** Amy Winn and Tami Bishop have resigned from the Planning Commission. Kyle suggested asking John Stark to be chairman. Margaret called and asked Mike Norman if he would be willing to serve on the Commission and he accepted. Alyssa texted Shannon Rasmussen and she accepted as well. They will come to the meeting tomorrow night and then be officially appointed at the next Town Council meeting.

**Cache County Trails Coordinator:** Kyle would like to support the County Trails Coordinator position and so would Margaret. Spencer is not sure that the Town should support this when we are trying so hard to take care of Paradise parks. Margaret made a motion to support this position, Kyle seconded that motion. All except Spencer in favor, Spencer is opposed.

### **Council Reports**

- **Roads-** Jay looked at the slurry seal work with Lee and felt that Morgan Paving did a good job. The edges of the road are sluffing off at the corner of 200 w. and 8800 s. Lee is going to work on that.
- **Water-** Kyle will check with Lee on when to start reading meters and see what help Lee needs. There is a leak at the new park due to a break in the line. Kyle and Lee will work on getting that fixed as soon as possible. Kyle will get with Lee and see if the Town Engineer has sent back the estimates for the water line they would like to run to the new park.
- **Community-** The Lions club and the Town Council are hosting a breakfast for all the Youth interested in joining a Youth Council on September 26, 2015. The Council will get names of some Youth in the 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade age bracket to Alyssa by the 10<sup>th</sup> and she will send Postcards personally inviting each kid to be part of the Youth Council and attend breakfast.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget-** Nothing to report at this time.

### **Unfinished Business:**

Mayor Rinderknecht asked if any of the Council members could pull the float or had an idea of someone that could pull it at the Trout and Berry Days float. The Council will be handing out Ice Creams and Alyssa will be in charge of booths so Karen will ask Bob Ensign.

Mayor Rinderknecht asked if the Council would be willing to add the Ted Woolf lot working meeting to the September 2, 2015 regularly-scheduled meeting. There was a lengthy discussion on what the best decision for this lot is. The Council thinks it would be best to have the State Ombudsman attend the meeting and help everyone involved come to a decision best for all parties. The Council suggested the working meeting be held approximately an hour before the meeting. The working meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. and then the regularly-scheduled Town Council meeting will be held at 7:30 p.m.

The September 16, 2015 meeting will be moved to September 23, 2015 due to half the Council members being at the League Convention.

The Council will look over a variety of Purchasing Policies and see what things would be good to implement in a Purchasing Policy for a Town of our size. This will go on the Agenda for September 26, 2015.

**New Business:** No new business at this time.
