

Paradise Town Council Meeting
September 2, 2015
7:30 p.m.

Council Members Present: Mayor Karen Rinderknecht, Margaret Obay, Jay Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith, Spencer Winn, Alyssa Petersen (recorder)

Townpeople Present: Dennis Olsen, Vic Little, Lee Atwood

Minutes: The Minutes of August 26, 2015 were emailed to all council members previous to the meeting. Jay made a motion to approve the Minutes as emailed; Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills: Margaret read the bills. Margaret made a motion to approve the bills as read, Jay seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment: No Public Comment at this time.

Appoint new Planning Commission Members: Mike Norman and Shannon Rasmussen have both agreed to serve as Planning Commission members. Margaret made a motion to appoint Mike and Shannon as Commission members, Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Planning and Zoning:

- **Dennis Olsen- Home Addition- 9345 S. 200 W.** - Dennis Olsen is building an addition to his home and attended the Planning and Zoning meeting held August 26, 2015. The Planning Commission approved the Zoning Clearance. The Council looked over the papers and application. Margaret made a motion to approve the addition to the home; Jay seconded that motion, all in favor.
- **Randy and Paula Moultrie- Barn-8800 S. 200 W.** – The Moultries are building a barn behind their home. They attended the Planning and Zoning meeting on August 26, 2015 where the Planning Commission approved the Zoning Clearance. Margaret made a motion to approve the barn; Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Council Reports:

- **Roads-** Nothing to report at this time.
- **Water-** Kyle reported that everyone affected by the new water line that runs down the Paul Danielson piece of land is still waiting for a recorded easement from Paul Danielson. Kyle talked to Paul and reported that Paul has it platted and it just needs to be signed. Once it is signed, the Town will have it recorded. Lee is still working on a cost sharing agreement for the users of the water line. Kyle, Lee, and the Water Company for the 9500 South Subdivision will have a meeting to finalize these things.

- **Community-** Margaret gathered names of high school kids that live in Paradise and would be eligible to participate on the Youth Council. She is working on gathering the names of junior high kids then Alyssa will send individual invitations to each of the kids and invite them to the breakfast to be served by the Lions Club and Paradise Town Council on September 26, 2015. Margaret will try to have the names to Alyssa by the 10th of September so the invitation can arrive and give them time to RSVP before the 26th.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget-** Blake brought in the cash and checks received from the Fire Department Trout and Berry Days breakfast. He brought in \$630.00, \$553.00 was in checks and \$77.00 was in cash. The Council double checked the amounts and Mayor Rinderknecht will take it in to the bank to be deposited.

Unfinished Business:

Mayor Rinderknecht received an email thanking the Town for being involved in the Junior Livestock show held at the Paradise arena. Jay reported that the show was well-attended.

Parks: Jason Summers attended the meeting to get the opinion of the Council on what kind of pavilion and restrooms should be built at the new park. They looked at a few options and plans. The Town will get an application turned in for a building permit by next week so it can be put on the Agenda for the September 24, 2015, Planning and Zoning meeting.

Kyle and Lee discussed how best to use the credit the Town has with Legrand Johnson. Johnsons is changing ownership and Kyle wanted to make sure that our credit followed over with the change. Lee will double check and make sure that it is credited on our account through the change of ownership.

New Business: None at this time.
