September 23, 2015

Council Members Present: Mayor Karen Rinderknecht, Margaret Obray, Spencer Winn, Alyssa Petersen (recorder)

Minutes: The Minutes of September 2, 2015 were emailed to all council members previous to the meeting. Margie made a motion to approve the Minutes as emailed; Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills: Margaret read the bills. Spencer made a motion to approve the bills as read, Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment: No Public Comment at this time.

Certification of Annexation Petition: Spencer made a motion to accept the Certification of the Annexation Petition, Margaret seconded the motion, all in favor.

Resolution 01-2015 Purchasing/Procurement Policy: Spencer put together some figures for a purchasing policy. The Council looked over what Spencer had put together and discussed some aspects of the Policy and added some different wording. Margaret made a motion to approve the resolution 01- 2015 Purchasing/Procurement Policy, Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Resolution 02-2015 Updated GRAMA Policy: Margaret made a motion to approve Resolution 02-2015 Updated GRAMA Policy, Spencer seconded that motion, all in favor.

Council Reports:

- **Roads-** Jay was not present at this meeting, nothing at this time.
- **Water-** Kyle was not present at the meeting, nothing at this time.
- **Community-** Margaret discussed some plans with the Council concerning the upcoming breakfast where youth 8th to 12th grade were invited to learn more about the Youth Council. She would like to serve juice, eggs, sausage, and pancakes. It was agreed upon that the Town would purchase the food for the breakfast. Margaret will charge it to the Towns local credit account at Ridleys grocery store. Margaret has talked to other Cities and Towns and learned more about how they form and keep kids active in a Youth Council. Lee Atwood and Kevin Norman with the Lion's Club asked Curtis Heaton about using the Cracker Barrel and he agreed to let them use the building. Margaret reported on her visit to the Salt Lake

City Sports Complex she visited while at the League Convention over the past week.

- **Grants/Fire/Budget-**. Nothing to report at this time.

Unfinished Business:

There will be a “Meet the Candidates Night” on Wednesday October 7, 2015. It will be held at 8:00 p.m. The regular Town Council meeting will be moved to 7:00 p.m. Karen asked the Council members to think of some questions they would like to ask the potential candidates.

Mayor Rinderknecht wanted to make sure that the Paradise trespass permits for the gravel pits are being issued for the same amount of time regardless of who is issuing them. The entire Council has the authority to issue the permits. The Council will all think about it and discuss this at a later meeting. Jason Summers suggested the Town get another place to shoot or a range.

Jason Summers brought in some quotes from three different companies and color samples for the pavilion and bathrooms at the new park. Kyle and Jason met with a fabrication company in North Logan at their pavilion and the fabricator did NOT think he could fabricate one like that at our park. The Council looked over the quotes and corresponding plans that Jason brought in. Jason asked the Council to take a pamphlet and some samples and to think about what colors they would like and then make a decision on this next week.
