**Minutes:** The Minutes of September 23, 2015 and November 4, 2015 were emailed to the Council members previous to the meeting. The Minutes of September 23, 2015 could not be approved without Spencer. Jay made a motion to approve the minutes of November 4, 2015, Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Bills:** Margaret read the bills; Margaret made a motion to approve the bills as read, Jay seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Public Comment:** No public comment at this time.

**Fire Department Expenditures:** The Fire Department would like to spend 750.00 to put the new logo/pin striping on the Fire Department trucks. Margaret made a motion to approve the spending of \$750.00 for pin striping. Margaret made a motion to approve the spending of \$755.45 for the purchase of the shotgun for the trap shoot raffle; Jay seconded that motion, all in favor.

**Pre-Disaster Mitigation Resolution:** Resolution 04-2015 states that the Town accepts and was involved in the Bear River Pre-Disaster Mitigation plan and has set up mitigation strategies for Paradise in case of a “disaster.” Jay made a motion to approve the resolution; Margaret seconded that motion, all in favor. Mayor Rinderknecht signed the resolution and Alyssa attested the signature.

**Paradise Sports Complex-Bathroom Review/Approval:** Kyle and Jason were not present at this meeting, this item was tabled.

**Council Reports:**

- **Roads-** Jay will check on when the Lions club would like to get the lights up.
- **Water-** Kyle was not present at this meeting.
- **Community-** The Youth Council will meet at 9:30 on Saturday November 21st at the Town Hall. The kids will meet at 8:00 a.m. to get everything set up at the Town Hall. All the kids involved have a job for the breakfast. They each made their own invitation and invited some of the widow/widowers in Town to join them for breakfast.
- **Grants/Fire/Budget-** Spencer was not present at this meeting.

**Unfinished Business:** Mayor Rinderknecht talked to the Council about Proposition 1. A letter has been sent to the Town. They would like to amend the bill and would like input from the Towns/Cities so that it can be on the ballot again next year. Margaret read over the letter sent from the County and feels that maybe Curt Webb would like to come explain the amendment to the Council so that they have enough information to make an educated decision.
