DOGS-Dog Licenses will expire the end of February. We will hold the annual Dog Licensing Clinic Saturday, February 27, 2016 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Watch for the sign when you come in to Town. If you can't make it to the clinic, please feel free to stop by the Office any time and get your dogs licensed. Attending the Clinic comes in handy if your dog(s) needs updated rabies or other shots. Clay Robinson is at the Clinic and offers those shots at a discounted price. Remember that if you have more than 2 dogs you will be required to apply for or renew a previously-obtained Kennel License.

With spring (hopefully) right around the corner, we would like to send out a quick reminder to keep your dogs home. Every year one of the biggest complaints we get is that dogs are running at large and disturbing people walking, working outside, kids playing, etc. Please keep your own dogs on your own property. If you feel that a situation calls for Animal Control then please call dispatch at 435-753-7555.
