

Paradise Town Council Meeting
August 17, 2016
7:30 p.m.

Council Members Present: Mayor Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith, Martell Lowe, Alyssa Petersen (Recorder)

Community Members Present: None Present

Minutes:

The Minutes of August 3, 2016 were emailed to all the Council members previous to the meeting. Kyle didn't get a chance to read over the minutes, he asked to table the Minutes until a later time.

Bills: Kyle read the bills, Kyle made a motion to accept the bills as read, Martell seconded that motion.

Public Comment: None at this time.

Discuss Fee Schedule for Arena: This item will be tabled until the next meeting.

Council Reports:

- **Roads- Martell Lowe** – Martell reported that Morgan Paving had come back and finished some potholes he was hoping they would finish. He is concerned about a cemented hole with a pipe in it on 9000 S. and 50 W. He asked Kyle if it was a Paradise Town valve/pipe, or if it belongs to Paradise Irrigation. Kyle will talk to Lee about it. Martell feels it is a safety concern and it needs to be addressed. Martell asked if there were any concerns about the sidewalks that have recently been put in. Vic had mentioned some concern over the sidewalk and discussed it with Lee. Mayor Rinderknecht felt that Lee and Vic had already discussed it with the contractors working on the sidewalk. Martell was also concerned about a “gouge” in the road on Hwy 165 at the very north side of town. It is on the highway and Kyle and Mayor Rinderknecht felt that the state should worry about that. There was discussion on the best options for maintaining the right-of-ways around town. The Council is debating hiring a second part-time employee to mow and having to purchase new equipment, or would it be smarter to contract with a company or person to maintain them. Mayor Rinderknecht asked Martell if he would be interested in looking for a contractor and getting prices to mow those right-of-ways two to three times per year.
- **Water- Kyle Smith-** Kyle talked to Lee about starting the water line project this year. Lee was going to talk to Bruce Smith about digging for the new line. Kyle will follow up with him and see if he had talked to Bruce about that.
- **Community-Vic Little-** Vic was absent from this meeting.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Spencer Winn-** Spencer was absent from this meeting.

Unfinished Business:

Kyle reported that the picnic tables were delivered and need to be put together. Kevin Norman is going to try and round up some volunteers to help put the tables together so they are ready for Trout and Berry Days. A dumpster was delivered to the Pavilion sight and Kyle is hoping to find some kids that would be willing to help clean up tomorrow evening. Kyle is thinking the pavilion should be finished tomorrow and everything can be cleaned up and hopefully have the dumpster picked up Friday. Kyle would like the kids to help clean up tomorrow morning or tomorrow evening. There was a discussion about what Eagle Scout Projects need to be done around Town. There are some trees at the new park that need to be watered where the sprinklers aren't hitting them frequently. Kyle is going to talk to Lee about maybe watering each tree specifically. They aren't looking very good.

Mayor Rinderknecht asked about who would like to go to the League of Cities and Towns. Kyle is buried but could potentially take one day and come down. Martell will figure out what he needs to do for work and see if he can schedule some time to go. Mayor Rinderknecht asked that everyone will let Alyssa know by this Friday. She will email the information to the two absent Council Members.

Mayor Rinderknecht let the other Council members know that the resolution to increase property taxes had been sent to the County.

Kyle asked about when we should put a draw in for the LWCF Grant. He is going to get all the donation information to Alyssa as soon as possible.
