Council Members Present: Mayor Karen Rinderknecht, Kyle Smith, Spencer Winn, Vic Little, Alyssa Petersen (Recorder)

Excused: Martell Lowe

Community Members Present: Fire Chief Troy Fredrickson

Minutes: The Minutes of December 21, 2016 and January 4, 2017 were emailed to all the Council Members previous to the meeting. Spencer made a motion to approve the minutes of December 21, 2016; Vic seconded that motion, all in favor. Spencer made a motion to approve the minutes of January 4, 2017; Vic seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills: Vic read the bills, Vic made a motion to approve the bills as read; Kyle seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment: None at this time.

Ron and Jace Foster- Discuss Eagle Scout Project Ideas- The Fosters were not able to make it to this meeting. They will reschedule for the next meeting.

Cache County Attorney's Office Prosecution Services Agreement- Mayor Rinderknecht explained that the County has asked that we sign an interlocal agreement. Spencer read through the agreement and was slightly concerned about a few points and would like to make sure that the County Attorney's Office would support our opinion when it came to prosecuting a case. Kyle is in favor of it. Spencer made a motion to accept the Agreement; Kyle seconded that motion, all in favor. Motion carries.

Council Reports

- **Road- Martell Lowe-** Martell was not able to make it to the meeting, but did leave a few notes for the Mayor to discuss with the Council. Martell is concerned about the slush on the roads and would like to make sure that the roads are scraped when the roads are slushy. Kyle feels like we need to make sure we are diligent when it starts to rain and be sure to get slush off the roads. Mayor Rinderknecht asked if it would be a good idea to look for a spreader to sand some bad areas. Kyle wonders about hiring one more person to help and feels like a new truck would be a good option. He would like to see the old truck plowing and get a new one so that two trucks would be plowing. He also suggested that at some point Paradise try to work out an agreement with Hyrum for sand and salt. Vic feels that with the amount of snow we received over the last few storms the plows did a good job and tried hard to keep up with it all. Vic was concerned with

the water that runs over the highway down by 8300 S. and worries it may be a potential hazard for Paradise residents.

- **Water- Kyle Smith-** Kyle hasn't talked to Lee yet but wanted to make sure that he had submitted or will submit the annual report to the State Division of Water Rights.
- **Community- Vic Little-** Vic has Dallan Passey working on getting the Youth Council together. Dallan is going over the list and making note of who has gone on and contacting those that may be interested in serving on the Youth Council.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Spencer Winn-** Troy attended the meeting. Mayor Rinderknecht reported that the Fire Department faucet had been fixed and that she is working on getting hot water up to the front bathroom. Troy asked if there was information on the sign. Vic reported that he has been in contact with the sign company and they will work with us to try and get the official bid and then the sign delivered as soon as possible. Troy may need to file an extension on the Grant so that there is not a time crunch on getting the new sign delivered and installed. The representative with the sign company said that it may be possible to move the sign if the Council doesn't like the placement. The current bid for the sign is for a 2 f.t. x 7 f.t. sign. Vic would like to get an extension and take some time to make sure the sign fits and looks the way the Council would like to see it look. There is a lot of concern about the current sign that is deteriorating. Mayor Rinderknecht asked Troy if he feels he could get an extension on that Grant. Vic asked Troy if he needed anything else from the Town concerning sending the brush truck out this year. Troy doesn't think they need anything from the Town now.

Unfinished Business:

Mayor Rinderknecht reminded the Council about the Public Hearing this Thursday at 7 p.m. concerning the Kennel Ordinance changes. She also reported that she had asked Ben Sorensen to serve on the Planning Commission. She is waiting to hear back from him. Kyle will talk to Jared Adams if Ben chooses not to serve on the Commission.

Mayor Rinderknecht reminded the Council that the after-Christmas dinner will be next Friday January 27, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at Sportsman's Paradise.

New Business:

Mayor Rinderknecht told the Council that at the next meeting the Council needs to approve transferring money to the road account from the Capital Improvements account to pay for the road work recently done. She also let them know that before the next meeting a notice would be published alerting the public of the three open seats on the Council up for election this coming November.

Adjourn: Kyle made a motion to adjourn; Vic seconded that motion, all in favor. Meeting adjourns at 8:03 p.m.
