Interview Potential Mayor Candidates- There was 5 candidates that submitted their name for Mayor. Michael Burns did not attend the meeting. Kyle smith pulled his name before the meeting. The Council asked Eileen Snider, Larry Johnson, and Lee Atwood questions about their background, and why they would like to be Mayor. They asked them what they could bring to the Town. After the Council had interviewed each of the three Candidates, Vic thanked them for coming and for participating in the meeting. Spencer made a motion to postpone appointing a Mayor until next meeting; Shannon seconded that motion, all in favor.

Minutes- The Minutes of January 3, 2018 were emailed previous to the Council. Shannon made a motion to approve the Minutes of January 3; Martell seconded that motion, all in favor. The Minutes of December 20, 2017 were emailed to the Council prior to the meeting. Spencer made a motion to approve the Minutes of December 20; Martell seconded that motion, all in favor.

Bills- Shannon read the bills. Spencer made a motion to approve the bills as read; Shannon seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment- None at this time.

Department Expenditures- Fire Department Jackets. The Fire Department ordered jackets for their annual Christmas Party. The cost came to \$2,563.69. Spencer made a motion to approve the expenditure, Shannon seconded that motion. Martell voted “no” on the jackets. Everyone else voted “yes.”

Council Quarterly Report- The Council reviewed the quarterly report. There were no questions.

Council Reports

- **Roads- Martell Lowe-** Martell’s main concern on roads is still the hole that needs to be covered on 9000 S. Lee reported that he talked with Ron Dymock (the Paradise Irrigation Company water master) and that Ron was still waiting on a bid from Ipaco for a cover. Once he got that, he would be able to get it covered.

- **Water-** Lee Reported that the pump has come on twice recently. Otherwise, we have run all year off of spring flow. He reported that the last time we were able to run off spring flow all year was 2003 or 2004.
- **Community-Vic Little-** Nothing at this time.
- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Spencer Winn-** Spencer reported that the Fire Department held its annual Holiday party on January 13, 2018.

Unfinished Business-

RAPZ/New Park- The RAPZ tax applications need to be received at the County by March 1, 2018. The Council discussed some ideas on how to request the funds and what they should be used for if awarded. There was discussion on the New Park and getting it completed. The Council would like to invite Kyle and Jason to the next meeting and find out where they are on the park and if Jason would like to continue requesting the RAPZ funds, or if he would like the Council to take that over.

New Business- No new business at this time.
