Now that there is no snow on the ground, it would be a great time to get any old vehicles or other junk items off the Town right-of-way. We will be mowing Town easements soon and ask that anything that may be in the way, could cause damage, or is potentially dangerous, be moved or disposed of so that we can get easements mowed.

All Christmas and like decorations that have served their purpose need to be removed.


Then we can have the cemetery spruced up for Memorial Day, which is only 8 weeks away!

FIRE DEPARTMENT MESSAGE

Safety Tips for Open Burning Season

Permits Are Required

Permits may be issued between March 30 and May 30 and between September 15 and October 30 in Cache County. Get a permit from <http://air.utah.gov/OpenBurning/form/index.php> or contact Cache County Fire District 435-755-1670. Weather conditions change rapidly, especially in the spring. Permits can be rescinded if conditions change suddenly, making it unsafe to burn.

1. The DAQ rules governing open burning can be found in the Utah Administrative Code (UAC) R307-202. This rule allows open burning of: clippings, bushes, plants and pruning's from trees incident to property and residential clean-up activities
2. When atmospheric conditions (clearing index of 500 or greater) indicates it is satisfactory to burn.
3. Burning shall not be done when atmospheric conditions of local circumstances make such fires hazardous; i.e. high winds, red flag, etc.
4. Burning should be done at a distance of more than 50 feet from any building, structure, or other combustibles.
5. Have a way to extinguish the fire, water source, shovels, fire extinguishers, hoses etc., should it become too large or begin to spread.
6. The burning area should be constantly attended by a competent person and should be completely extinguished before being left. All fires should be completely extinguished before dark.
7. Applicant must be in legal control of the land on which the burning is to take place.
8. Adjacent neighbors should be notified prior to burning.
9. Such burning should not pose a threat to forest, range, or watershed lands.
10. If your fire extends beyond your control you should immediately call the fire department at 911.
